IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiffs shall serve and file any comments to proposed Case Management Order I on or before Oct 18TH, 1985.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendants shall serve and file any responses to plaintiffs' comments on or before Oct 25TH, 1985.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order to Show Cause and proposed Case Management Order I shall be published in the New Jersey Law Journal as soon after the entry of the Order to Show Cause as possible, the party responsible for serving that such publication is made to be designated by the Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that publication of this Order to Show Cause and proposed Case Management Order I in the New Jersey Law Journal shall be constructive notice to all parties in the litigation without the necessity of formal service upon each party.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pending the above return date of this Order to Show Cause, all filing deadlines are stayed and relaxed pursuant to R. 1:1-2.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pending the return date of this Order to Show Cause no discovery proceedings are to be initiated.
