
**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Plaintiffs in the above listed cases shall have until **April 1, 2019** to comply with the expert disclosures requirement set forth in Case Management Order No. 14 (ECF No. 741).

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the parties shall attempt in good faith to reach agreement on a joint proposed scheduling plan for the above listed cases, and shall file such proposed scheduling plan no later **February 8, 2019**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the next status conference with respect to the above listed cases shall take place on **Friday, April 5, 2019, at 9:30 a.m.** Lead counsel for each party shall appear in person, but any other counsel wishing to appear by

telephone may do so if counsel notifies the office of the undersigned of his or her intent to do so at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance of the scheduled conference.

No later than **seven days** before the next status conference, lead counsel shall file a joint status report setting out the topics that the parties wish to address during the conference.
